## What you'll need:

- Copy of the game
- Scissors
- A die
- Items related to the challenges on the board. For example, paper and pens, skipping rope, newspaper, sticky tape.

**Before you start:** Take a look at the challenges on the board. Create your own 90s themed challenges and add them to the yellow squares. Cut out the game pieces.

**How to play:** You can play in teams, pairs or individually. Each player or team needs a game piece. Role a die and make your way around the board, completing 90s challenges as you go!

**Try it this way:** Mark out the game board in your unit meeting space and physically move around the board to play a life-sized version!
