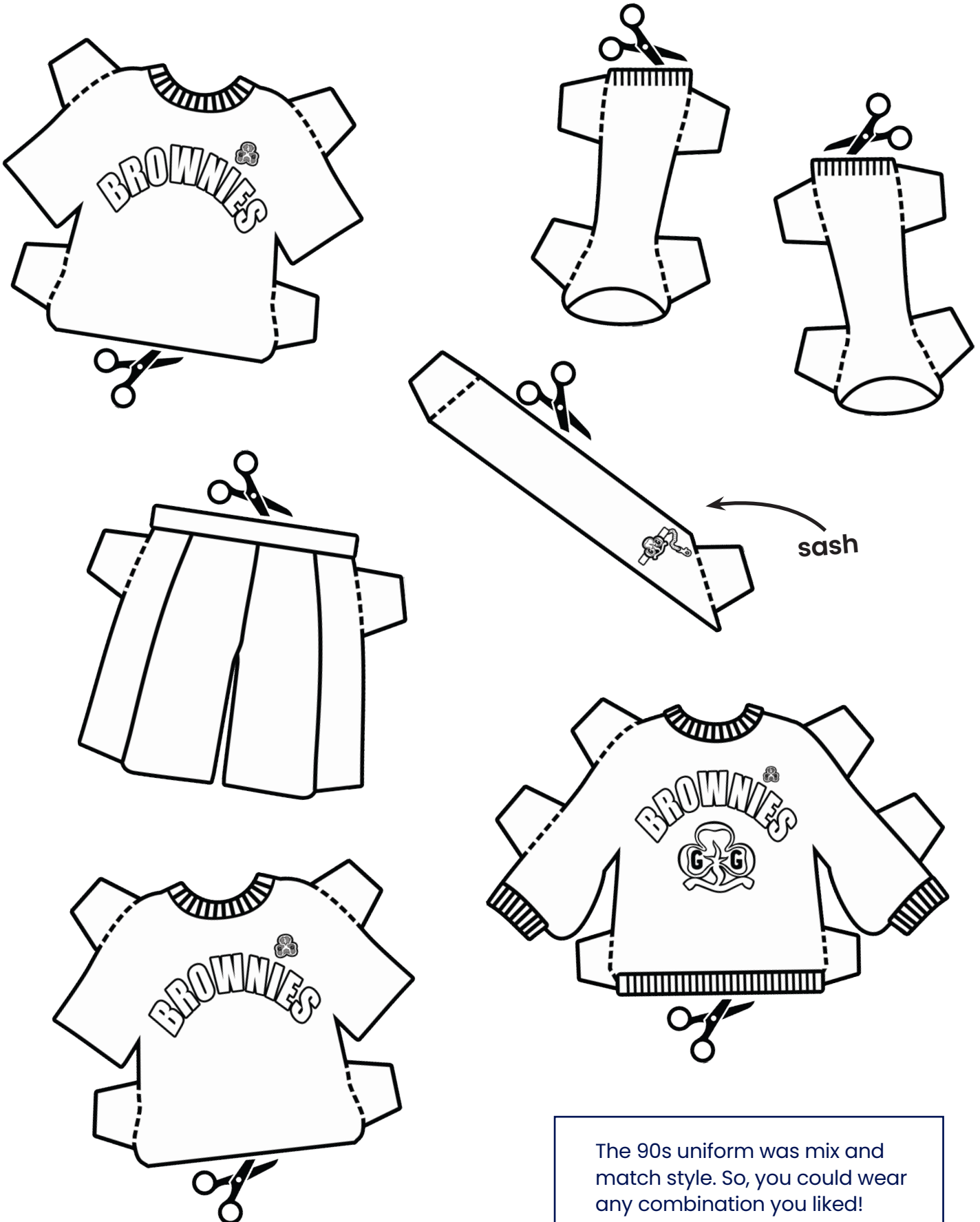
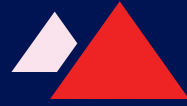
Top tip: Ask an adult or look up Girlguiding badges from the 90s. Draw some badges onto your dolls uniform!





Rainbows had 6 coloured **tabards** to choose from: red, yellow, orange, green, blue and violet.

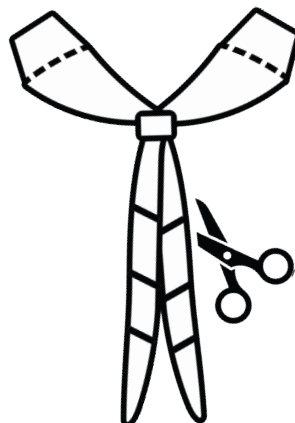
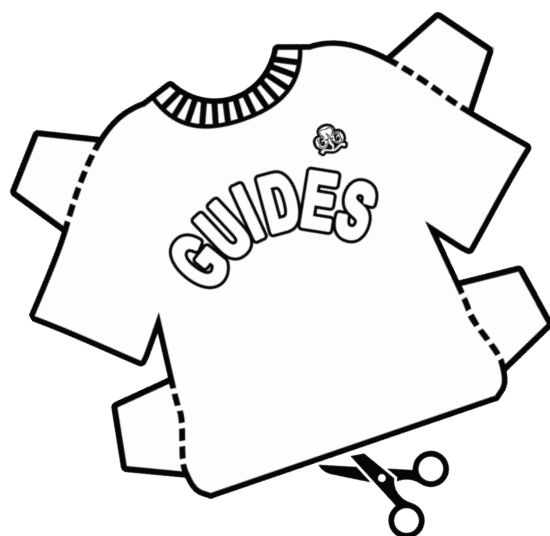
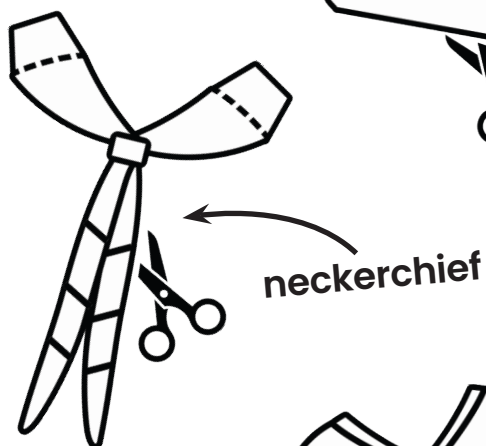
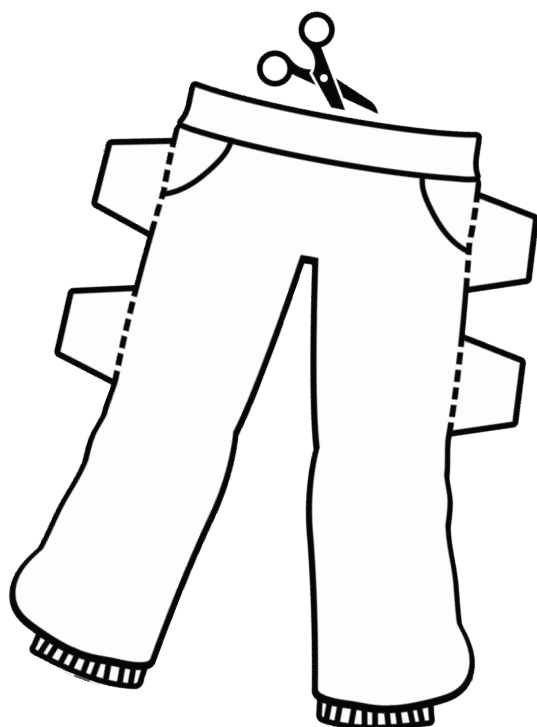


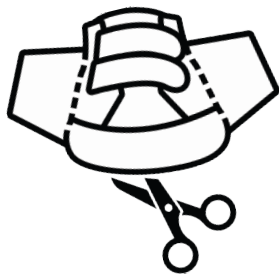
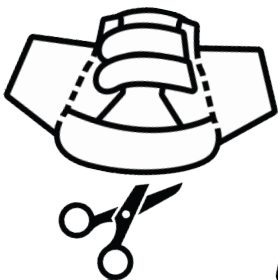
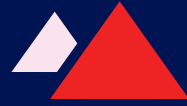


The 90s uniform was mix and match style. So, you could wear any combination you liked!
